

C. ROADMAPS – For students entering after September, 1 2018

NOTE: For all students entering prior to September 1, 2018, speak to your advisor about your roadmap. SEE APPENDIX F.

Advanced Standing students have earned a baccalaureate degree in social work (BSW) from a CSWE accredited social work program within the past six years and have an overall degree GPA of 3.00 or better. Persons who have undergraduate degrees in other fields are not eligible for advanced standing.

Full Time students are enrolled for two academic years of traditional weekday classes from early September to mid-May. The week is divided between classes and assigned field work. Field work begins in the first year of studies.

Part time (extended) students are enrolled in a minimum of 3 classes (9 credits).
